### Traffic Info

On Thursday, December 5, 2013 E Main Street in downtown Clayton will be closed from Smith Street to O'Neil Street between the hours of 5:00 pm to 9:00 pm. Through traffic traveling eastbound can detour to US 70 via Shotwell Road, Moore Street and Robertson Street. Westbound traffic can detour to US 70 via Durham Street and Smith Street.

### Parking

- Limited Parking for handicapped and elderly residents who would like to attend the activities between Barbour & Lombard streets will be available at Annie V's Florist, 111 S Barbour St – accessible from E Second Street.
- Limited Parking for handicapped and elderly residents who would like to attend the Tree Lighting will be available at the Town Square parking lot at Second and O'Neil Streets.
