Clayton Community Center 715 Amelia Church Rd.

- 1/16 mile indoor walking track
- Treadmill/Step machines available
- Programs, Classes & Athletics

Clayton Community Park 1075 Amelia Church Rd.

- 1/2 mile paved loop trail
- Unpaved wooded trail
- Picnic & Restroom Pavilion



Legend Park 550 City Rd.

- 8 miles of mountain biking trails
- Drops, jumps and skill zones



Sam's Branch Greenway 1358 N. O'Neil St.

- 1.25 miles of paved trail to the Neuse River, connecting to Clayton River Walk on the Neuse
- Outdoor Public Art Exhibit



Clayton River Walk on the Neuse Greenway 2686 Covered Bridge Road

- 4 miles of paved trail along Neuse River, connecting to Raleigh
- Scenic pedestrian bridge overlooking the water
